Hill / Wiltschinsky - Guitar Duo - Saturday March 15th 2003

Robin Hill and Peter Wiltschinsky are currently celebrating their 30th anniversary as a permanent duo and during this period have performed extensively world - wide. In 1987 they made their London Debut at the Wigmore Hall and have subsequently, through their recordings (6 CD's), broadcasts and foreign tours, established themselves as one of the finest duos in the world. They have recently collaborated with the Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra, the BBC Concert Orchestra, the Irish National Orchestra and the Orquesta Sinfonica Gran Mariscal de Ayacucho. The duo are utterly unanimous, vigorous, charismatic and have redefined virtuosity. Indeed, the only world-class duo Britain has produced.
